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EFFECTS OF ACUTE EXPOSURE -IRRITATION OF EYES, SKIN AND UPPER RESPIRATORY SYSTEM. MAY CAUSE NERVOUS SYSTEM DEPRESSION. EXTREME OVEREXPOSURE MAY RESULT IN UNCONSCIOUSNESS AND POSSIBLY DEATH. HEADACHE, DIZZINESS, NAUSEA, AND LOSS OF COORDINATION ARE INDICATIONS OF EXCESSIVE EXPOSURE TO VAPOURS OR SPRAY MISTS. REDNESS AND ITCHING OR BURNING SENSATION MAY INDICATE EYE OR EXCESSIVE SKIN EXPOSURE.

EFFECTS OF CHRONIC EXPOSURE:ETHYLBENZENE IS CLASSIFIED BY IARC AS POSSIBLY CARCINOGENIC TO HUMANS (2B) BASED ON INADEQUATE EVIDENCE IN HUMANS AND SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE IN LABORATORY ANIMALS. LIFETIME INHALATION EXPOSURE OF RATS AND MICE TO HIGH ETHYLBENZENE CONCENTRATIONS RESULTED IN INCREASES IN CERTAIN TYPES OF CANCER, INCLUDING KIDNEY TUMORS IN RATS AND LUNG AND LIVER TUMORS IN MICE. THESE EFFECTS WERE NOT OBSERVED IN ANIMALS EXPOSED TO LOWER CONCENTRATIONS. THERE IS NO EVIDENCE THAT ETHYLBENZENE CAUSES CANCER IN HUMANS. PROLONGED OVEREXPOSURE TO SOLVENT INGREDIENTS IN SECTION 2 MAY CAUSE ADVERSE EFFECTS TO THE LIVER, URINARY, CARDIOVASCULAR AND REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEMS. REPORTS HAVE ASSOCIATED REPEATED AND PROLONGED OVEREXPOSURE TO SOLVENTS WITH PERMANENT BRAIN AND NERVOUS SYSTEM DAMAGE.
